The advanced, innovative clubs will provide students with opportunities to experiment with their surroundings as a form of problem solving through coding using LEGO bricks, coding software, and curriculum relevant STEM challenges. Elementary students will become literate in coding and be prepared for future computer programming courses in middle and high school. The elementary school STEM/Science labs have also added equipment to provide hands-on learning experiences to promote student curiosity in the sciences and engineering. A LEGO simple machine, engineering, and robotics kits have added opportunities for students during science lessons, as well as after-school science clubs to explore hands-on learning.

The Greater Pike Community Foundation was created to enable generous individuals, families, and local businesses to maximize their charitable support through organized, targeted, long-term community philanthropy, providing a permanent and personal way to give back to the region.
